## Why the Elite Edge Hockey Showcase?

- More than 10 hours of ice time in game and practice situations – NEW FOR 2012 specialized forwards/defensemen practice for each group
- Exposure to scouts and coaches from professional, NCAA Div. I/III, USHL, NAHL, Canadian junior and top AAA programs
- Showcase against more than 200 top AAA and high school players from throughout North America
- Four hours of specialized training with NHL strength and conditioning coaches
- Eight hours of seminars and off-ice training sessions – including video sessions with NHL video coaches
- Team building sessions to help develop team work and leadership skills
- A post-camp meeting with the player, parents and Elite Edge Hockey Showcase coach – with a take-home evaluation

## What is different about the Elite Edge Hockey Showcase?

- **ELITE EDGE Exposure** – With more than 50 professional, college, junior and AAA programs represented the exposure opportunities for every player in attendance are like no other program provides.
